Motion made Ray Carroll, seconded by Jennifer Hughey to increase Tucker's compensation by \$0.50 per hour. Motion carried with all ayes.

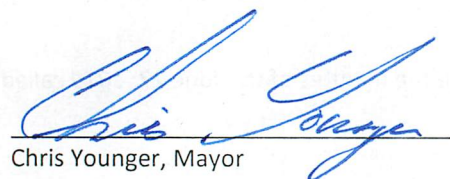
New Business

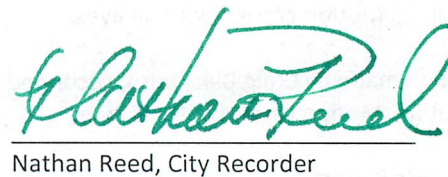
