Motion made by Michael Barron, seconded by Fred Ivie to adopt Resolution 2019-308, a resolution to establish policies and fees for the cleaning of private sewers. Motion carried with all ayes.

Motion made by Jennifer Hughey, seconded by Tom Mikkelsen to approve PO 9026 to Tennessee Tractor for \$3,174.92 for repair to a lawn mower. Motion carried with all ayes.

Motion made by Michael Barron, seconded by Jennifer Hughey to approve PO 9013 to Alford's Tire for \$2,737.32 for fire truck tires. Motion carried with all ayes.
