The mayor asked Bradley Skinner to find out when the work can be done and take care of getting the old sidewalk dug up and removed and prepared for the new work. Motion made by Marty Graves seconded by Jennifer Hughey to get repairs done soon as possible. Motion carried with all ayes.

Mayor stated that he did not think that the Ambulance building should be sold. Other cities in the county contributed to this building he wanted it to be something the whole county could get use out of. The board has approved the Dyer Jr. Fire program and would like to allow them to use this building. He wants a sign with their logo on this building and for the juniors to move there things to this building. The mayor made the board aware that there would be no extra cost to the city. Motion made by Bryan Cathey seconded by Jennifer Hughey to use to Ambulance Building as the new Jr. Fire Building. Motion carried with all ayes.

Motion made by Jennifer Hughey seconded by Bryan Cathey to donate \$5000 to Dyer Station Celebration. Motion carried with all ayes.
