

The City of Dyer Board of Mayor and Alderpersons met in regular session on Monday December 8, 2025 at 7:02 pm. Those present were Mayor Chris Younger, Alderpersons Michael Barron, Jessica Dickinson, Bryan Cathey, Nathan Reed, Marty Graves, Kayla Hall, and Bett Jewell. The city attorney was not present.

Motion made by Bryan Cathey, seconded by Jessica Dickinson to approve the minutes of November 24, 2025 regular meeting. Motion passed with Cathey, Reed, Jewell, Graves, Barron, and Dickinson voting aye. Kayla Hall abstained.

Motion made by Bryan Cathey, seconded by Kayla Hall to allow Roger Jones to address the board. Motion carried with all ayes. Roger Jones has recently moved to town and has a business painting, and pressure washing. Jones also offers his pressure washing services to senior citizens in need who might have trouble funding it otherwise.

Mayor's Report

Motion made by Bryan Cathey, seconded by Marty Graves to decline the full time Firefighter grant. The board discussed that the matching portion on this grant was greater than what we the city could comfortably budget for. Motion carried with all ayes.

Department Reports

Public Works Supervisor Dale Carroll informed the board that PRI is continuing their patch work around town. Carroll also informed the board that they had to repair a water main on Scattered Acres and are stilling sucking leaves.

The City Recorder reminded those present about tax relief.

Committee Reports

Mayor Younger informed the board that new Christmas décor items had been purchased for the mini park.

New Business


